SPECIAL TOWN MEETING WARRANT – JULY 8, 2025, at 5:00pm

For the Special Town Meeting to be held on Tuesday, July 8, 2025, in Penobscot County, ss.

To: Kevin Noyes, a citizen of the Town of Patten, in the County of Penobscot.

GREETINGS:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Town of Patten in said County, qualified to vote in Town affairs, to meet at the Patten Public Works Garage located within the said Town of Patten, at 5:00 PM on Tuesday, July 8, 2025, there and then to act upon Articles 1 through 3, all of said Articles being set out below to wit:

Article 1: To choose a Moderator to preside at said Special Town Meeting.

Article 2: To see if the Town will vote to reappropriate \$25,000 from the 2025 Annual Town Meeting appropriation of \$224,950 for Winter Roads (Article 17) for the purpose of funding the Community Activities Coordinator position.

These are excess funds from the Winter Roads budget since the contract for winter maintenance ended up being \$41,000 less than expected.

Article 3: To see if the Town will vote to reappropriate \$10,000 from the 2025 Annual Town Meeting appropriation of \$224,950 for Winter Roads (Article 17) for the purpose of funding a pickup truck for the Ambulance Department. Additional funding will be provided by the Penobscot County Commissioners (\$28,000) and \$22,000 from the EMS relief funds from the State of Maine.

These are excess funds from the Winter Roads budget since the contract for winter maintenance ended up being \$41,000 less than expected.
